Sewing Machine and manual

Darning Foot and Walking Foot.

Extension table.

Notions such as seam ripper, scissors, etc.

Sewing Machine Needles. In addition to your regular needles, please bring Schmetz Topstitch 90/14 and 100/16.

Good sewing light.

Multi-plug extension cord with surge protection.

Extra empty bobbins.

Marking pens used for marking designs on your quilt top for both light and dark fabrics. I recommend you bring several. I suggest Mark-B-Gone or Wonder Marker for light colored fabrics and Clover White Marking Pen or the Stabilo white pencil. If you need a source for the Stabilo pencil please email me and I will forward that to you.

Unquilted pieced tops for designing. Bring several if you can!

Vintage linens such as tablecloths, dresser scarves, pillow cases, doilies, etc.

2 yards of fabric and sufficient batting for a small wholecloth quilt. Be creative! Fun fabrics such as Dupioni silk, hand-dyed yardage, etc. make beautiful wholecloth pieces. If you plan on basting during class also bring **basting safety pins, backing and batting.**

1 yard muslin and scrap batting for practicing quilting techniques.

Sheet to cover your work at night.
