NEW DIRECTIONS: CLASS SUPPLY LIST

Sewing Kit—whatever YOU need to sew and work well and comfortably

Sewing Machine, multi-plug extension cord with surge protection,

4' x8' piece of Fleece, flannel, or batting to cover design surface

Masking tape

Large cutting mat—size 23"x17" is recommended

Rotary Cutter

Cutting Rulers: straight edge, size: 24"x 6"

Large square, size: 12"-15"

Fabric and Paper Scissors

"Chalk type" pencils, or fabric markers of some kind (optional)

Pad of Tracing Paper, size: 11"x14"

Sketch Pad, size: 11"x14"

Sharpie Pens

Glue stick or the like

Pencil for sketching

Pen for taking notes (don't worry, they'll be brief)

Note pad

Table-top light

Sheet to cover your work at night

Collect and bring to class pictures of art work, landscapes, images that you like.

Use magazines, postcards, note cards, calendars, photos etc.

Include intriguing color combinations (from advertisements, for example)

FABRIC: Bring the fabrics you like to work with, and the fabrics you want to explore. In addition to prints, include some solids, mottled, hand dyes, "solid-ish" fabrics.

For all fabrics, bring 1/2 yard to 1 yard pieces; good range of colors; range of values dark to light (**have some very light and some very dark**). Include some scraps, if you wish.
