### ART DECO

#### **Class Description**

Students will design an Art Deco quilt using basic geometric shapes which were typical of this era. The design process will involve making a scale mock-up of the quilt design using colored construction paper and graph paper. A piecing sequence will be developed for the mock-up. Once the piecing sequence is done a full size quilt will be constructed to match the design. This process can be used for any other pieced art quilt. Students will feel liberated when they learn these simple design techniques.

**Skill level:** Any

#### **Kit Fee**

A kit fee of \$30.00 will be charged to each student. This fee will cover all of the supplies needed to construct the mock-up of the quilt design.

#### **Materials List**

1. Rotary cutter
2. Ruler
3. Cutting mat
4. Seam ripper
5. Scissors (fabric and paper)
6. Straight pins
7. Thread
8. Scotch tape
9. Note paper and pencil
10. Background 3 yards, 5 other fabrics 3/4 to 2 yard cuts. These are on the generous side just to be safe.
11. Multi-plug extension cord with surge protection
12. Table-top light
13. Sheet to cover your work at night
14. Sewing machine in good working order and appropriate accessories
