

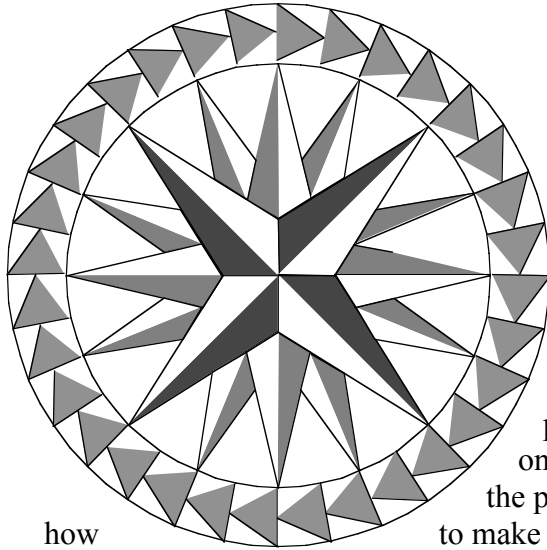

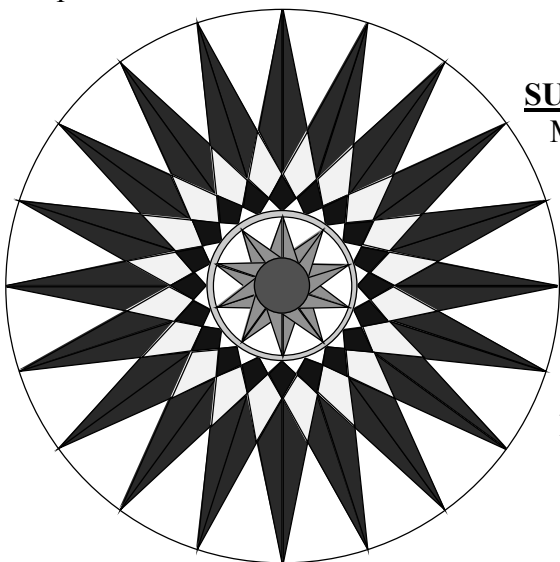
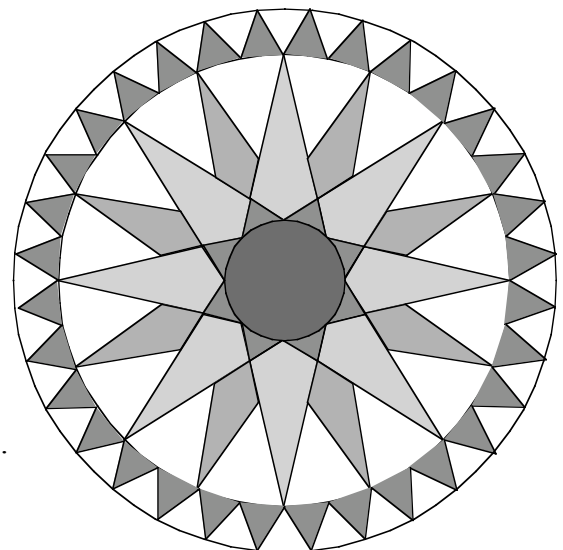
to make the points nice and sharp. MACHINE PIECE

Learn to draft and piece these exciting radiating stars (mariner's compass type) into circles, ovals or off center circles. Draft your own formal, symmetrical star into nearly any shape and size or create a flashy off center star or select a pattern from Judy's book. The designs will be drafted or copied onto freezer paper and then cut directly into foundations to simplify the piecing process. We will deal with color inspiration as well as

#### MATERIALS LIST:

You will choose your own project so it is hard to say how much fabric. More fabric is wonderful, but at **least** 2 yds background fabric of solid or non-directional print in either dark or light values. Avoid mediums for background. Dark backgrounds are particularly dramatic but light values are effective as well.

1/4 yd of 6 to 8 fabrics for a **single** large star, chosen to contrast with the value and color of the background. Small to medium size prints work easily, but stripes, checks and plaids are dramatic and exciting in the star points.



#### SUPPLIES:

Matching thread (star value), pins. Fabric and paper scissors.

Rotary cutter/ruler/board Table-top light, multi-plug extension cord with surge protection, sheet to cover your work at night.

3 yds freezer paper - also available in class for a small fee

Drafting materials 1/4" graph paper 8-1/2"x11", 18" C-through ruler with holes -optional, compass, protractor, sharp regular pencils and two colored pencils.

SEWING MACHINE IRON with auto shut off and pad. (Small low wattage irons are good). **Not the tiny Clover.**
