SUPPLY LIST

Learn more about making miniature quilt blocks which were the basis of Jane Stickles' Civil War quilt. Challenge yourself with more difficult techniques including machine and hand-piecing, using freezer paper templates and appliqué.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

Machine in good working order, Multi-plug extension cord with surge protection

Needles, thread, thimble, pins, fabric cutting scissors, paper cutting scissors, table-top light, rotary cutter, mat and ruler, sheet to cover your work at night;

Dear Jane Tools, pencil, iron with auto shut off feature, if driving (or share in class), freezer paper

Fabric:

Assortment of ten to twelve 1/4 yard pieces of 100% cotton fabric - include lights, mediums, darks, stripes, plaids, some backgrounds; if you wish to follow a certain theme- Amish, 30's etc, bring those fabrics; each quilt block can be made with about 8 square inches of fabric
