Independent Study

Because of the structure of an independent study workshop, with students working on a variety of projects, it is difficult to pinpoint an exact list of supplies. If students plan to bring an existing project to class, they should bring supplies they know will be needed to continue with that project. For those who wish to embark on a new design, the following supply list will be helpful.

SUPPLY LIST

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Sewing machine needles
- Piece of fabric to cover your workspace
- Table-top light
- Multi-plug extension cord with surge protection
- Iron with auto shut off and ironing pad
- Something to cover your work at night
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter and cutting rulers
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors for paper and fabric, needles, pins, seam ripper, thimble, seam roller)
- Design paper or lightweight cardboard sheets
- Tape (masking /white/not blue)
- Pencil and eraser
- Acid free white glue sticks
- 8 ½" x 11" clear transparencies (Instructor will have some available for purchase)
- Ultra Fine Point Sharpie pen/black and a few lighter colors
- Freezer paper or Pellon fusible interfacing
- Inspirational photos you have taken or have permission to use 4" x 6" or larger
- Fabric and Threads you would like to include in your project



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
