- Lady of the Lake pattern and fabrics**
(approximately US \$ 57.00 and the fabrics will cost approximately between US \$260- \$285). Contact these stores (they may have the kits and the original fabrics for you): Compass Point Quilts in New Hampshire, the Quilt Foundry in Maumee, Ohio or Quilting at the Bay in Panama City, Florida
- Thread:** personal I like to work with a white cotton thread.
- Cutting Mat:** A 12" x 18" mat next to your machine works well.
- Pressing:** Finger pressing or a pressing tool works well, but for those of you who like to really press: irons will be provided in the classroom.
- Clover Glass Head Pins:** # 2507 A lot.
- ¼ Add-a-quarter ruler if you need one**
- A Paper-Creasing Tool:** a piece of cardstock or template plastic approximately 2" x 8" works well
- Rulers:** Some of you may enjoy using an Add-a-Quarter ruler. I like a small 6 ½" x 6 ½" ruler. It is an all-purpose ruler for small paper-piecing projects. If you have strips to cut from the full width of your fabrics, a 6 ½" x 24 ½" ruler will come in handy.
- Rotary Cutter:** 45mm is great....for those tighter curves, 28mm is a huge help. A new blade is a necessity!
- Scissors: Small,** sharp fabric scissors for just in case.
- Scissors: Large** with a sharp blade. I prefer to work with the large purple Karen Kay Buckley scissors
- Zip-lock bags:** to store your pieces or fabrics
- Freezer paper.**
- Cellophane tape.**
- Glue stick.**
- Several bobbins:** 3 or 4 Pre-wound bobbins the same as your top thread will save you time in class.
- Don't forget to clean and oil your machine prior to coming to class.** I'm not an expert;-) on the mechanics of your machine. Bringing your manual may help if a problem occurs with your machine while you are in class.
- Sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal with a new needle**
- Machine needles:** Always good to have extras on hand!
- Your fabrics!... don't leave them at home!
- THE ORIGINAL PATTERN:**Try to cut all the fabrics for the paper foundation parts according the cutting instructions in the pattern. It saves a lot of time and maybe frustration if you are prepared for class and you can start immediately with sewing instead of cutting. So take a few hours of your time in the coming month to prepare yourself....
- Seam Ripper:** We know no one makes a mistake, but just in case; a ripper can come in handy.
- Pencil and / or Pen:** And paper, to take notes, if necessary.
- Bottled Water:** It's important to hydrate.....piecing is hard work! ;-))

I am so looking forward to meet you all in class.... And please don't be afraid.....

I will show you the most easy way of paper piecing you have ever done
and you will see that something that looks so complicated..... can really be fun and nice!
