# Fractured – Improv Design

Work with improvisation techniques with intent to create a stash buster quilt with one simple shape! We will work elements of contrast to establish interesting lines and shapes. Design your own layout or make *Fractured*, an all time favorite. *Fractured Heart* or *Red Center*. Quilting options will be discussed as well.

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS



*Fractured* is a great quilt to make from your stash! To make the quilt as pictured, there are 56 blocks of two fabrics. The sample shown is based on 56 lights and 56 darks with a minimum of 5" x 25" for each fabric. Consider working any form of contrast that you like considering:

- Light and Dark
- Warm and Cool prints
- Print and solid
- Print and Batiks
- Large scale prints and small scale

### SUPPLY LIST

- Sewing machine in good working order
- General sewing supplies
- Table top light and multi-plug extension cord with surge protection
- Something to cover your design board (Best is Queen Size batting that can be used for the quilt after class)
- Something to cover your work at night
- Paper and pencil for sketching

**Note:** This quilt is all about working with contrast. It is always good to have at least this amount of different fabrics so bringing lots of options is advised. Feel free to use prints and large scale prints as well.

Other quilt patterns using this technique include:

- "Fractured Heart" from *Adding Layers*
- "Red Centre" from *Making Quilts*
