Improvisational Piecing with Painted Fabrics



This class will take your creativity to a new level. You print the fabric then create a design as the spirit moves you. Your hidden artist goes for an amazing ride! A truly one-of-a-kind quilt is your reward.

Start by creating your own fabric. Learn to use paints, stencils, stamps and tools to create one of a kind painted designs using a mono print gel plate. These fabrics are a fabulous addition to any quilter's stash—ready to be used the day you paint them and totally permanent on fabric. Then take these fabrics and make a quilt. Work without a pattern. Work without a scant ¼" seam allowance. Work without straight lines. Create and cut as you go. In the class you will learn to piece curves without pins and create blocks like no one else has ever made before – these will be your original artwork.

Purchased kit (\$65) includes:

- 8"x10" Gel Press Plate
- 3 yards fabric ready to be painted
- 6 colors of paint (1oz bottles of Dylusions paint)
- Brayer
- One 9x12 stencil

STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Basic Supplies:

- Rotary cutter, 45mm or 28mm size
- Rotary mat: 18" x 24" recommended
- Cutting ruler: 4" x 12" works great and a square ruler, a least 9.5" x 9.5"
- #50 weight, 100% cotton piecing thread, neutral color
- New sewing machine needle, Size 70 Microtex for piecing
- Spray sizing
- Straight pins
- Apron to protect your clothing
- Tabletop light with extension cord and power strip, if driving
- Something to cover your work at night

The instructor will bring many additional supplies for you to use during class and many additional items that you may purchase to continue your adventure in painting your fabric.
