SUPPLY LIST

- Two (2) copyright-free color nature photos,** 8" x 10". These will serve as your inspiration photos. See this web page with further information. If desired, I'll take a look at your potential photos. Send them to me at least 1 week prior to the first day of class. **Please send no more than 3: elindner@cfl.rr.com**
- Clear plastic page protector (1 or 2)
- A few paper towels sheets
- Paper scissors
- Glue stick
- Sketch book, or a few loose papers (no lines)
- Pencil with eraser
- 12" ruler
- Fabrics to match photo colors. See web page with fabric examples.
- Fabric for an optional border
- Muslin, 2 yards
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Straight pins
- Washout/iron off fabric pencils/chalk
- Camera/camera phone
- Table-top sewing light and a multi-plug extension cord with surge protection. (If Driving)
- Something to cover your work at night

ITEMS FOR OPTIONAL SEWING

Quilting/sewing in class is optional. It will be fully discussed, but if you'd rather do it when you get home, that's fine.

If sewing, bring:

- Sewing machine, matching threads, and all sewing supplies
- Regular sewing foot, plus one for 1/4" seam allowance, if you have it
- Highly recommended, but not required: a darning foot (for free motion sewing,) or a walking foot. You must be able to attach and use whatever sewing foot you choose, as well as being very familiar with the overall use of your machine.
- Batting and backing fabrics, 2 yards each.
- Whatever fusible web you have on hand. We'll only need a little.
