Creating the Illusion of Depth in Art Quilts

STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Important—Choose a color palette and coordinate it throughout your supplies.

- Three colors transparent fluid acrylic paint**
Bring 3 or 4 related paint colors.
If you buy paint, I recommend *Golden Fluid Acrylics*.
- Paint brushes**
 - 3—5 inexpensive chip paint brushes from hardware store
 - A few 1 inch & 1 that is a little wider than 1 inch
 - A few foam brushes
- Acrylic gel medium:** at least 8 oz., matte or semi-gloss
- Pad of heavy paper:** bristol, watercolor paper, mixed media
- A few large Ziploc bag/bin of misc. materials such as:
 - Fabric scraps—edges from squared-up quilts, small pieces you might not be able to use for anything else
 - Lightweight tissue type papers (old wrapping stuff, old sewing patterns....)
 - Old newspapers, magazine images....
 - Found objects
If you can sew it down, it's fair game!
- Basic paint supplies** such as containers, apron, and texture tools...
 - Small container for water at your table
 - A few rags or paper towels for clean up
 - Thick & thin black *Sharpies*
 - A box of latex gloves
 - A few small pieces of sheer fabric
 - Small amounts of cheesecloth, scrim or gauze
 - Small piece of flat cotton batting
- A few sheets or a packet of art paper
 - Stay in your color palette
 - Vary texture and thickness
 - Example here:

- Painting tools**
 - outside of the box stuff like toothpicks, old tooth-brushes
 - anything you can create textures with
 - favorite stamps or stencils
- Favorite collage ephemera
- Paper & cloth **scissors**
- Straight pins
- Painter's tape—optional
- Apron
- Sewing machine/basic sewing tools/thread optional**
 - Or bring hand sewing tools
- 2 yds. duck cloth canvas—natural color
 - 7 oz. works well; Unprimed
If you can't find this, bring fabric that is equivalent to duck cloth in density.
- 1 yd. black canvas duck cloth
- 1 yd. Regular weight *Wonder Under* fusible webbing
- 5—10 fat quarters of fabric that relate to one another
We do not need yardage, so think small amounts
- 3—4 unscented dryer sheets
- Table top light and a multi-plug extension cord with surge protection (If driving)
- Something to cover your work at night
