# Improvitational Quilting Irene-Style: “Dancing with the Wall”

### STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

- Sewing machine and all stuff that goes with sewing: scissors, rotary cutter, cutting mat, marking pens/chalk, pins for pinning pieces together and for putting onto design wall, thread
- A quilting ruler at least 4”x14”. Helpful for squaring up components made improvisationally
- White Flannel or quilt batting 6’x7’ (to cover design wall)
- Sketchbook and pencil or pen or your other favorite drawing implement
- Spray starch
- Fabric:
  - 2 yards white or off-white
  - 2 yards of a dark (black, dark brown, navy, maroon, forest green)
  - 1-1/2 yards each 4-5 different colors of fabric, solids or small prints that read as solids that “talk nicely” to each other and that you love
- Table top light with a multi-plug extension with surge protection
- Something to cover your work at night
