## Adventures in Paper Piecing



Whether you are a devoted Judy Groupie or want to try your hand at paper piecing, here is your chance to create a visually stunning quilt while you learn and master Judy's organizational and piecing techniques. Get help with choosing your colors, reading the pattern, and start to finish assembly. You have the option to work on any Quiltworx pattern during this immersive, hands-on class. Prior paper piecing experience not required. Yes, you can do that! Jeanette Walton, a Judy Niemeyer Certified Instructor, will guide you through, step-by-step, to making your gorgeous quilt.

### SUPPLY LIST

- Fabric and pattern! Patterns available through Jeanette with a 15% discount and free shipping. Pattern cost and fabric requirements will vary based on pattern selected.
- Sewing machine with 1/4" foot (no guard)
- 12" Add-a-quarter ruler (not required, but highly recommended)
- 6" by 12" ruler
- One piece of Template Plastic (3" by 12" piece) for fold template. Cardstock can also be used.
- Good quality thread (I like Aurifil)
- Microtex 70/10 Sharp needle
- Seam Ripper
- Scissors
- Repositionable glue
- Glue Pen (Fons and Porter or Sewline recommended)
- Fabric glue stick – (UHU stick/Elmer glue stick recommended)
- Flower flat head pins (preferred) or pins of your choice
- One gallon size or larger Ziploc style plastic bags for organizing fabrics and papers (varies based on pattern selected).
- Jumbo trombone style paper clips (these are regular paper clips but bigger)
- Cutting mat (18" by 24") Recommended, but smaller OK if traveling)
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Portable light for your workstation, particularly if you plan to work at night.
- Small iron and ironing pad (optional); irons and ironing boards are provided in the classroom.
- Something to cover your machine at night

**Be sure to cut out your papers and fabric before class.**  
**You don't want to spend all your time in class cutting papers!**  
**Pre-class Zoom instruction for cutting papers and fabrics available.**
