Materials:

- Roll of Freezer Paper
- 2 yds for Background fabric (consider bringing multiple options)
- 1 yd for Centers
- 10" strips of a variety of 10-20 fabrics
Select fabrics that are light, medium and dark values as well as warm and cool colors for best results
- Sewing Machine

General Sewing Supplies

- Cutting Mat and ruler
- Something to cover design wall
- Iron and ironing mat
- Add-A-Quarter ruler (optional but handy)
- No Pattern Required
- Table top light with a multi-plug extension cord with surge protections (If driving)
